- 3. Start or join a prayer group at your church, and meet regularly to pray for a missional team.
- 4. Invite a friend to take a walk with you and use that time to pray together for global workers.
- 5. Fast one meal per week and use that time to pray for a people group.

Note on Restricted Communication: For our workers and partners that serve in sensitive areas, we use initials or aliases instead of their real names. They each face unique challenges based on various security and safety concerns, so our communication policies are tailored to their particular needs and requests. Also note that some of our key national partners are not included in this directory at all due to heightened concerns. Please pray for those who face challenges like these as they lay down their lives in love and obedience to serve God.


