JUNE 2025 - FEBRUARY 2026, 3RD QUARTER YEAR-TO-DATE, UNAUDITED

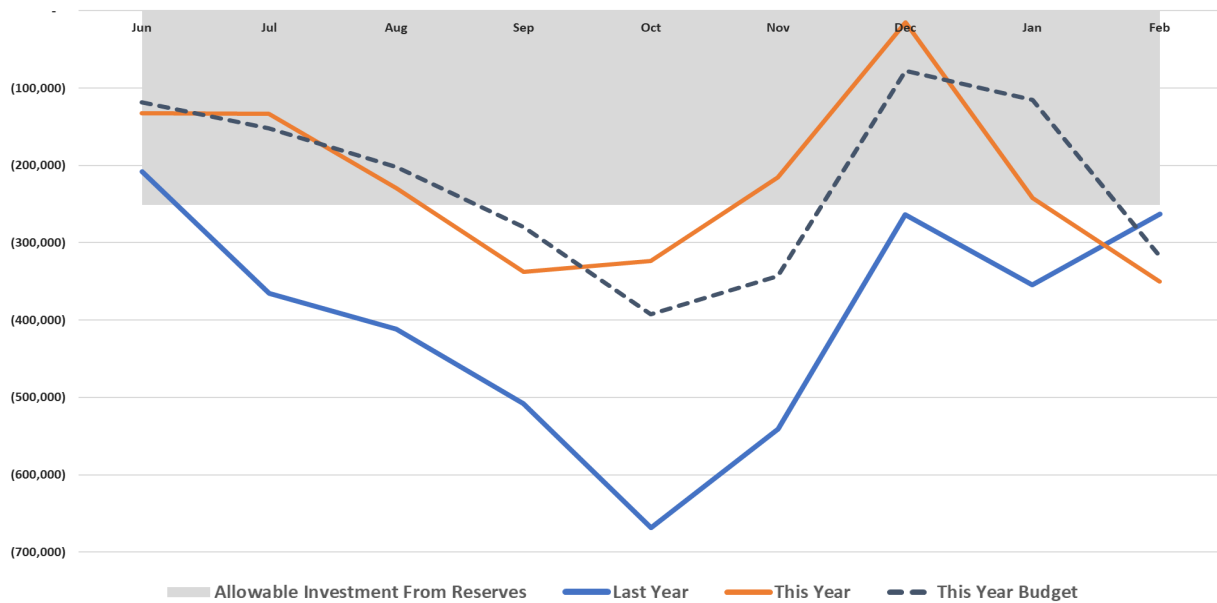
This year our board approved using \$251K of our previous years' reserves to further our strategic initiatives. Due to some unexpected write-downs in our Canadian investments (\$143k this year), we are behind budget for our year-to-date net position. We are currently \$33k behind our year-to-date budget.

## Net Results (\$USD)

In addition to the net results shown here, our global workers and ministry projects have added \$331K to their restricted reserves which are held separately on our balance sheet. Combined, these projects have \$3.1M of reserves.

## Cumulative Net Results By Month

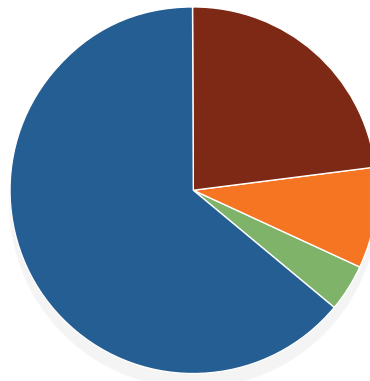

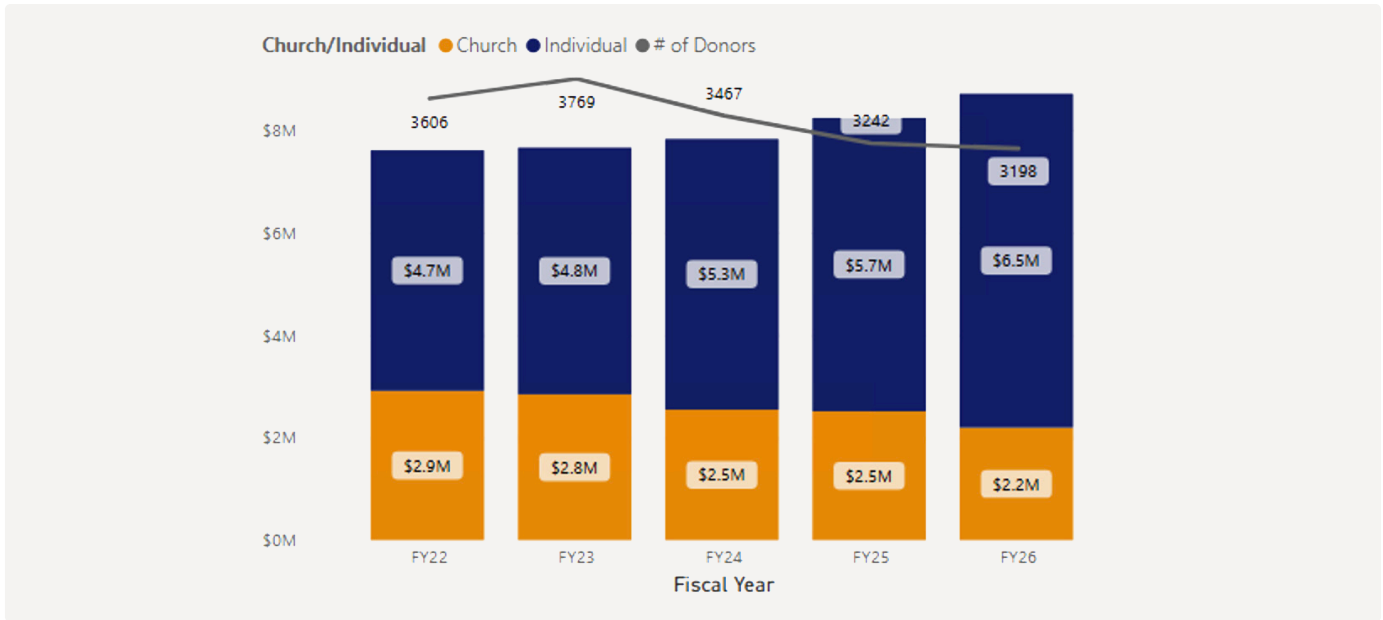

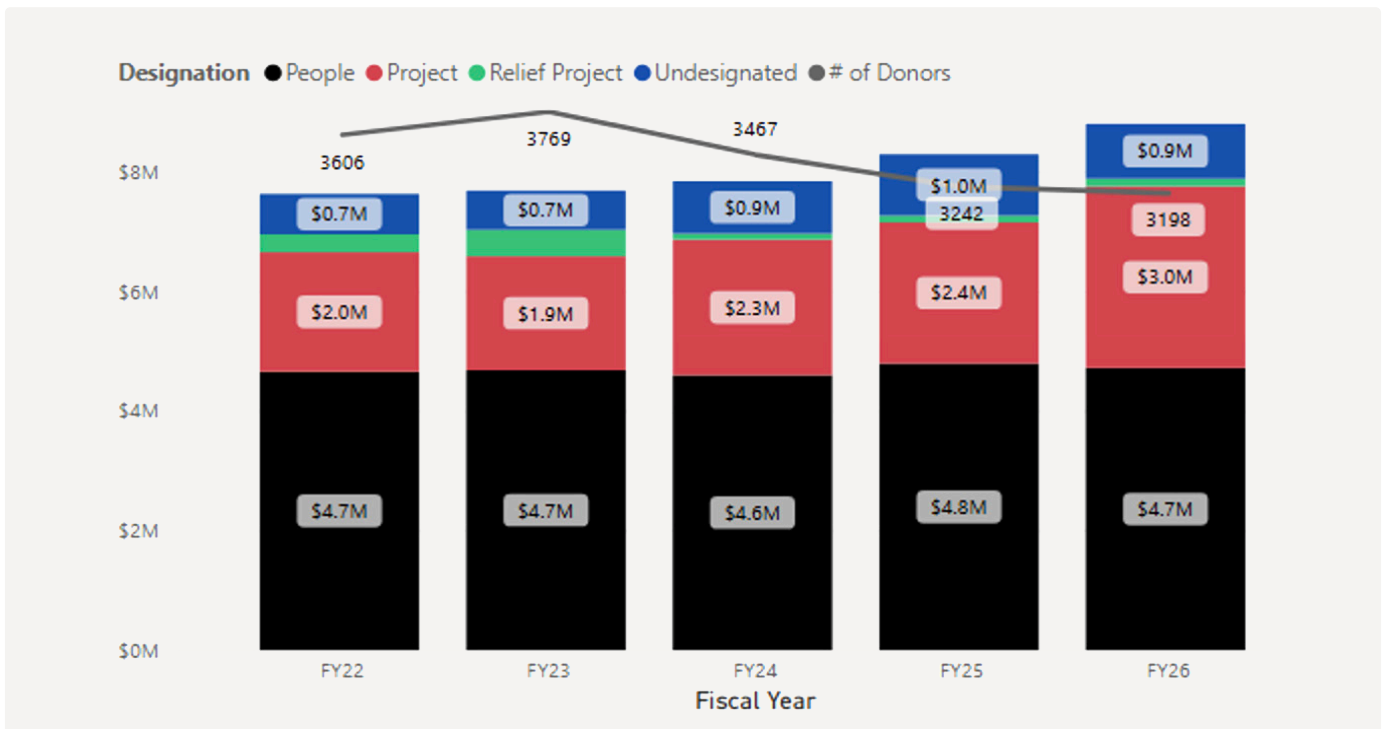
