



Lithuania Summer Camps

Thank you for your financial generosity and prayers for the outreach ministry of the Lietuvos Laisvųjų Krikščionių Bažnyčia (Lithuania Free Christian Church, LKB) in Siauliai, Lithuania. Your support has assisted the church community by enabling them to provide much needed relief to Ukrainian refugees. They have collected food and clothing donations and have also provided shelter for those displaced by the ongoing war.

The LKB church, led by Valdas Vaitkevičius, has received and housed over fifty Ukrainian refugees thus far. This refugee ministry is taking place together with all the other projects, camps and outreach programs this church is faithfully administering.

By the grace of God, Valdas and his team of volunteers were able to host three kids' outreach programs this past summer, amidst the ongoing crisis of the war. The camp's focus was to reach children from socially disadvantaged families with the hope of the Gospel.

They had ninety Lithuanian children attend, of which twenty were from their day care center and the rest of the children came from the surrounding cities. They were also able to host twenty Ukrainian children who live on the church's premises with their mothers. This outreach event was a huge blessing to these families. The camps were held in two languages, which was challenging for the leaders, but with God's enabling and strengthening, all the children were taught about Jesus' big love for them.
